THE BRITISH GROUP & THE IPU

British Group Inter-Parliamentary Union (BGIPU) is the official national group representing the UK Parliament in the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU). BGIPU's membership comprises all sitting members of both Houses of the UK Parliament, across all political parties and the cross-benches of the Palace of Westminster.

Founded in 1889 by MPs from the UK and France, the IPU is the world's oldest multilateral political body. For more than a century it has been the focal point for world-wide parliamentary dialogue, fostering contacts between parliamentarians on questions of collective international concern. The IPU seeks to unite MPs globally to encourage collective parliamentary action for a more peaceful and prosperous world, advancing democratic norms and institutions and defending the rule of law and human rights.

BGIPU is led by a Chair elected annually from among its membership, along with three Vice-Chairs and a Treasurer as part of a 30-member Executive Committee supported by a permanent Secretariat fully funded by both Houses of Parliament. BGIPU coordinates an active and varied programme of bilateral interparliamentary exchanges with other IPU member parliaments worldwide with the primary aim of advancing the parliamentary dimension of Britain's foreign relations.

MAIN ACTIVITIES OF THE BGIPU

The BGIPU's aims to service Britain's and the UK Parliament's interests through advancing the parliamentary dimension of Britain's foreign relations.

IPU Conferences and activities

Sends delegates to International meetings on key global matters, including global meetings of the WTO Conferences & the UN Commission on the Status of Women.

• Overseas Delegations

Coordinates Bilateral exchanges between members of the UK Parliament and other national Parliaments with the objective of increasing understanding and cooperation between both countries.

Welcoming Parliamentarians to Westminster

Arranges formal bilateral exchanges in the United Kingdom with members of Parliament from IPU member states.

Seminars and Conferences

Convenes seminars, conferences and lectures for UK Parliamentarians, foreign Parliamentarians and key parliamentary stakeholders on issues of current interest.

All Party Parliamentary Groups

Supports and promotes affiliated All Party Parliamentary Groups (APPGs)

MEMBERSHIP OF THE BGIPU

Members of either House of the UK Parliament are automatically members of the BGIPU and eligible to participate in its activities.

- Develop better understanding of crosscutting issues such as sustainable development, gender equality, human rights, conflict resolution and climate change on the global agenda
